Whilst a majority of our work is carried out on cats and dogs it is not limited solely to those species. We are happy to investigate heart disease in any animal and those that we have already seen include:

<u>Rabbits</u>

We have performed Doppler echocardiography on rabbits with Congestive heart failure (CHF) or Cardiomyopathy.



Ferrets

Ferrets are known to suffer from congestive heart failure in later years, like all species once diagnosed they cannot be cured but medication can give them a good quality of life. Echocardiography is still the gold standard for diagnosis of heart disease in these animals and we are happy to undertake this for you.



<u> Horses</u>

We don't expect you to bring your horse to us, our ultrasound scanner is portable and so we can come out to you to perform ECG and echo examinations. We are happy to discuss cases over the telephone prior to visiting.

<u>Leopards</u>

Yes we do mean leopards. Sarah has recently been involved in the European Captive Breeding Programme (EEP) for the Amur Leopard working alongside John Lewis of The International Zoo Veterinary Group (<u>izvg.co.uk</u>) and Wildlife Vets International (<u>wildlifevetsinternational.org</u>).

Sarah has been doing echocardiographic examinations of the Amur leopards that are held in Zoos and Wildlife Parks across the country to detect any abnormalities or congenital heart problems which would mean that the animals could not be included in the captive breeding programme.
